Grape Varietals: Cabernet with small amounts of Merlot, Malbec and Petite Verdot

Wine Making: The grapes for this wine are donated from the Doc Stewart Vineyard, the oldest vineyard on the Wahluke Slope now owned by the Gilbert Family, one of Washington's great wine growing families.

Tasting Note: Blackberry and cassis are prominent with herbal notes including mint, thyme and sage and earthy chanterelles to create a complex and appealing wine.

Serving Suggestions: A solid partner for traditional meats or something new such as goulash, beef and ginger stir-fry or fried tofu with spicy sesame sauce.

Fun Facts: A surgeon turned farmer, Doc Stewart was among the first to see the potential of the Wahluke Slope which at the time was a wasteland of tumbleweeds and dust.
