The Grenache and Syrah based wines of the south of France are approachable, drinkable, and affordable. The Grenache and Syrah grown in our state is no exception - it has become increasingly popular with Washington wine drinkers. This fruit-forward blend is a beautiful blue and purple hue. Clear and bright, jammy plum aromas enhance this youthful wine, which is full of spice and cherries on the palate.
